This Indenture made this twenty  
ninth day of April in the year of our Lord  
One thousand seven hundred and ninety five  
Between David Philips and Mary Philips his  
— wife of St Clair Township Allegheny County & State of Penn-  
sylvania of the one part, & John Lauramee of St. Township County &  
State of the other part, KNOW ALL THAT in pursuance of a Virginia  
Certificate granted to the said David Philips by the Commissions Appointed  
to settle and adjust the claims of unpatented Lands in the Counties of  
Yohiogenia, Monongahala and Ohio, was surveyed unto the said David  
Philips by the said Certificate in his own name on Peters Cross in the  
State aforesaid for whom a Warrant of acceptance Issued the first  
day of April one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight and in  
Consequence of which a patent was granted to the said David Philips  
at Philadelphia April the fifth one thousand seven hundred and
