

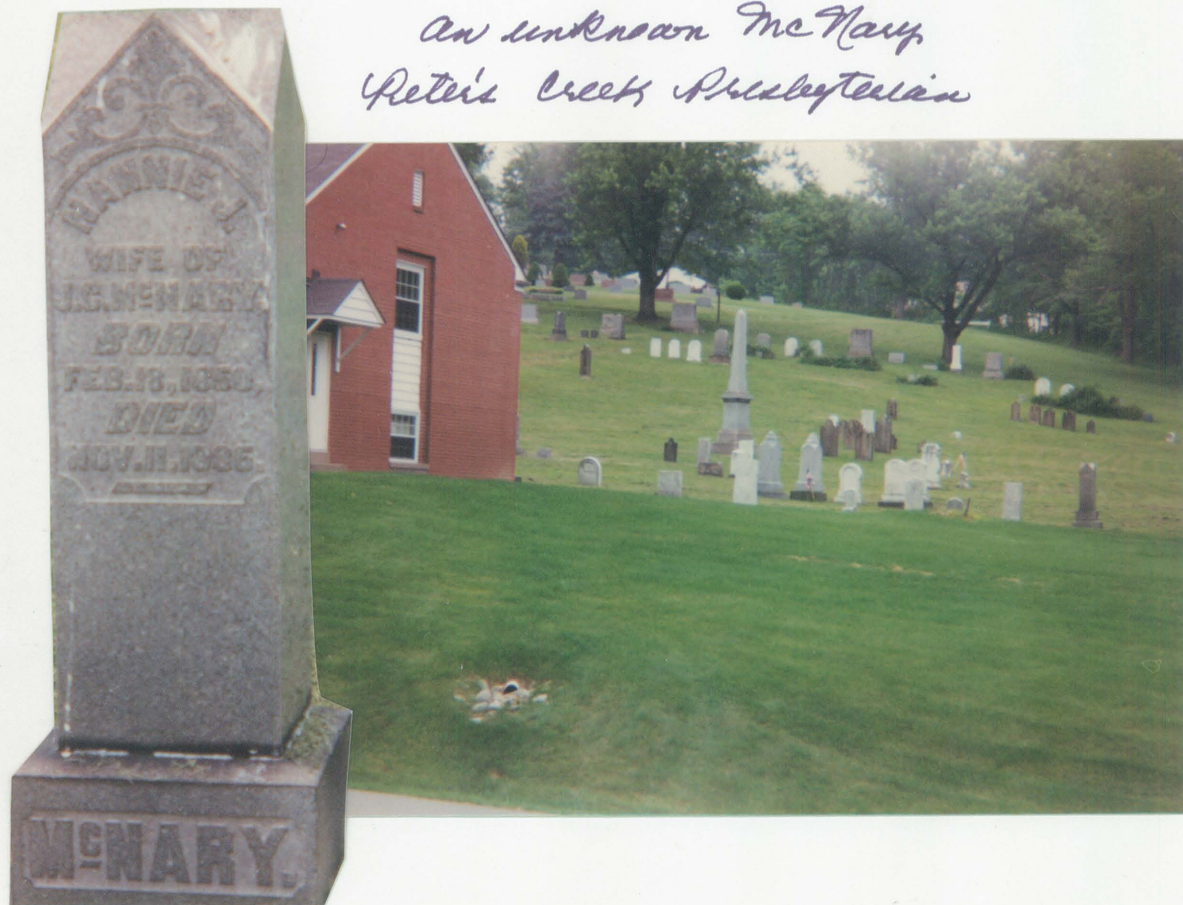

Phillips, Boyer, and a Larimer, Peter's Creek Baptist

Mr and Mrs William J. Hart rented the farm from 1913-1943 for \$25 per month. They had a dairy farm - milk picked up for Rock-McJenkins. In summer they baked bread outside in an oven. Their four children were Betty (TRAX), Charles, Robert, & William. The Harts all graduated from Bethel High School. At first they rented from Tom W Larimer. After Tom died in 1919, his son Frank took over. Tom had had 2 sons and 2 daughters (one was Annie May h. Yofall)
