Lawrence, widow (formerly Lawrence) of the same place, parties of the second part, witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of One \$1,000 Dollar, to them now paid by the said parties of the second part, a good bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, All that certain tract or piece of land, situate in the Township of Bethel, County of Allegheny, and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows to wit: - Beginning at a stone at the corner of land of M. J. Lawrence and W. P. Philips; thence by said W. P. Philips, North fifty four (54) degrees, thirty-one (31) minutes West, four hundred thirty and ninety hundredths (430.90) feet to a stone; thence by land of Peter S. Boyer North two (2) degrees, ten (10) minutes East, five hundred seventy-nine and six hundredths (579.6) feet, to a stone; thence by same land North eighty (80) degrees, fifty five (55) minutes West, four hundred eighty-seven and fifty hundredths (487.50) feet to a stone; thence by same land North Two (2) degrees, ten (10) minutes East, seven hundred thirty-seven (337) feet to a point; thence by land second described herein South seventy-eight (78) degrees, forty eight (48) minutes East, three hundred ninety-nine (399) feet to an iron pin; thence by same land South four (4) degrees, five (5) minutes West, two hundred fifty-six and eighty hundredths (256.80) feet to an iron pin in the center of a public road leading to Liberty; thence by same land and by the middle of said public road South seventy-six (76) degrees, twenty-two (22) minutes East, three hundred ninety-eight and eighty hundredths (398.80) feet to a point; thence by same land and same road South forty-nine (49) degrees, twenty-two (22) minutes East, three hundred and eighty-one (381) feet
