County of Bernalillo and State of New Mexico and MABEL LARIMER, his wife of the City of
Pittsburgh, County of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania; CHARLES A. LARIMER and FRANCES
LARIMER his wife of the City of Wray, County of Yuma, State of Colorado and ANNA MAY LARIMER
YOXALL and HARRY YOXALL, her husband, of the Borough of Ingram, County of Allegheny and
State of Pennsylvania parties of the first part and CHARLES M. PROVOST of the Township of
Upper St. Clair, County of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania party of the second part;

(265.93) feet to a point; North 49° 24' West Seventy and 84/100 (70.84) feet to a point;
