## Changes 1950 - 1958

Dorothy and Earle move to apartment in Mt Lebanon. House is built for Howard & Edith + baby Susan near Trolley line and Bequa Drive. Earle + Dorothy move in to that house when the Sandars later move to Cockeysville. Inside of the farm house is gutted. Basement which had a shallow stone foundation, then dirt walls and floor, is cemented. Top floor is lowered about 3 feet. North wing (kitchen) is added. Porches are cemented + lattice of front porch replaced with painted metal columns. Apartment and attached garage are built under front porch.

November 3, 1951. Mark arrives. We still live at 656 Dewalt in Rolling Hills but move into farm before school out in May, 1952. Our dog bucky rides out in the pick-up with Dad and cries real wet tears all the way. We live in the apartment, but have a T.V. in the unfinished living room.
